Movable Archives Technology and knowledge to design the future

The Olivetti historical heritage became the case study for designing and prototyping movable archives, which are accessible from a distance. Domus Academy, Associazione Archivio Storico Olivetti and Co.Ideas launched an educational workshop for Domus Academy Master in Interior and Living Design students and young designers from all over the world. Students were asked to design movable installations that provide access to the Olivetti historical collections of the Ivrea factory.

During the workshop held between November and December 2017, the students explored and experimented with both the educational contents and the aesthetical aspect of their proposals. They elaborated pilot projects which gave visibility to Olivetti Company's historical heritage, through research, analysis and experimentation, starting from the historical collections of the archives of *Associazione Archivio Storico Olivetti*. The students submitted seven projects with drawings, graphics and renderings in which technology and social values, humanities and design, culture and interaction, which intertwine to provide solutions for an alternative vision of the future.

The Museo Nazionale della Scienza e della Tecnologia Leonardo da Vinci will host the public presentation of all projects. Thanks to the contribution of a young and innovative Piedmontese company, Co. Ideas, the projects have been realized and will now be exhibited to the public.

The values of the cultural project conceived and realized by the historic brand of Ivrea were the stimulus for a proposal where knowledge and community as well as accessibility and community are the common denominators to look at the future.

The initiative has received the support of the *Museimpresa* Association to which the archives and the museums of the most important Italian companies belong.

The projects will be presented to the public at 6.00pm on 7th February 2018 at the Sala Conte Biancamano (Via Olona 6bis entrance) of the Museo Nazionale della Scienza e della Tecnologia Leonardo da Vinci.
